Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in our Medical Reception and Pharmacy Assistant Courses.

As you will be aware, by talking with our staff, our courses are very comprehensive and offer much needed skills and experience for our students to gain employment.

As we understand that not all students are able to cover the cost of their training in part or in full, we have researched and provided this guide to all the possible funding options which are available.

Please ensure that should you wish to apply for any funding pathways that you are aware of all the Terms and Conditions associated with them. MediTrain do not endorse or encourage students to take up Funding options which are not in the best interest of the student. All funding applications and subsequent repayments if applicable remain the responsibility of the student.

MediTrain courses: All fees are due at least one week prior to course commencement. Should you be applying for any of the funding pathways, please ensure to contact one of our friendly staff to see if a reservation into your desired course will be possible until all applications are finalized.

PLEASE NOTE - Centerlink, your JSA Consultant and WANILS will determine any eligibility and repayment details. We encourage you to ask questions and should you decide to contact these companies we would encourage you to thoroughly read and understand any documentation prior to proceeding.

1/ If you are a Concession Card holder, you can apply for an Education Entry Supplement with Centerlink. (MediTrain Education Institution ID Number – **6P245**) This is a \$208 lump sum payment paid to you from Centerlink once training commences if you are deemed eligible. You would be required to make payment to MediTrain as per our Terms and Conditions (Full payment required 1 week prior to training commencing) and then Centerlink would make payment to you if eligible, after course commencement. (PLEASE NOTE – Centerlink will not make payment to you until after course commencement – You will still need to self-fund the course in full and await reimbursement from Centerlink.)

2/ If you are a Pensioner or Concession Card holder, you can apply for a Pensioner Education Supplement which is an increase in fortnightly benefits while you are studying. It can be anywhere from \$20 - \$60 depending upon your benefit received.

3/ You can apply for financial assistance through your Job Services Australia (JSA) Provider. Dependent on the Stream they have you listed as, they can cover some or all of the cost. You would need to make an appointment with your consultant to see if you are eligible.

4/ You can apply for a Western Australia No Interest Loan Scheme (WANILS). The loan scheme is available if you are a current concession card holder and you have been living at your residence for 3 or more months. (Please see separate attachment)

You can contact them on 13 24 90 and quote our Centerlink Educational Institution ID Number: **6P245**. We are on the approved courses list for endorsed training. Please ensure you give the operator our company name – MediTrain and the state in which we are – WA. ***Enrolment in the course and full payment is required before you can apply for this assistance.***
